- In Q2'20 the group achieved 21 mln PLN of sales (-95% y/y). Gross profit fell to -83 mln PLN. Enter Air reported -45 mln PLN of EBITDA. Net loss was close to 56 mln PLN. The results were lower y/y because of negative impact of COVID-19 and lock-downs, which where implemented in the majority of countries.
- Sales of "Air services" segment was around 20 mln PLN, while "On-board sales" division generated 1 mln PLN of sales.
- In may'19 the group acquired 49% of swiss company Germania Flug AG. Enter Air decided to change it's name to Chair Airlines and started transformation of business model to B2B. In previous reports, the company pointed out that Enter Air is not interested in other acquisitions and the future growth will be based on current assets. Chair Airlines has 3 airplanes (Airbus A319).
- Cash flow from operating activities was close to -103 mln PLN (vs 149 mln PLN last year).
- COVID-19:
 - o The management board claims that impact of COVID-19 will not be a threat for continuation for running a business:
 - The company took some steps to reduce costs (payrolls) and CAPEX (the company postponed the deliveries of 0 Boeing B737-8 MAX):
 - The company renegotiated terms of lease payments;
 - The banks, which cooperate with Enter Air, had offered additional credit lines (c.a. 250 mln PLN);
 - The group is going to apply for financial help from PFR (max. 400 mln PLN); 0
 - The management board claimed that tour-operators, which are main clients, have stable financial standings; 0
 - The company proceeded scenario analysis and each of the cases suggests that company will survive current 0 crisis.

Summary of Q2'20 results:

Enter Air was trying to reduce it's costs, however because of the negative impact of COVID-19, the results of the company were much lower than in Q2'19. We notice that net debt grew significantly vs Q4'19 (according to MSR 17 +111 mln PLN). We expect that similar negative trends will continue in H2'20, but we hope the results will recover in '21. We point out that several countries implemented new restrictions due to next wave of COVID-19.



Quarterly sales [min PLN]




